

North Shore LAC - Police Press Release

North Shore Proactive Unit Police arrested and charged a 30 year old Seaforth male with a number of warrant and property offences on Monday. (2/2) Police were patrolling the St Leonards area when they sighted the male acting suspiciously near the intersection of the Pacific Highway and Christie street, around 3.50am. After speaking with the male Police conducted a number of enquiries via Police radio, which revealed the male had three outstanding arrest warrants. Police arrested the male and subsequently searched him, locating three pairs of designer sunglasses, a digital camera and a moderate amount of cash in his possession. He was arrested and taken to Chatswood Police Station, where he refused to be interviewed. He was charged with three outstanding warrants, two counts of Goods In Custody, and one count of being found with intent to repeat an indictable offence. He was refused bail and will appear at Hornsby Local Court today.

North Shore Police arrested and charged two males with a number of property offences in Roseville last Wednesday morning. (28/1) Police were called shortly after 12.20am after the resident of a Larkin Lane property disturbed three males in his carport. Police responding to the call located a white Ford Falcon parked in a nearby street, with the two males inside. After speaking with the males Police searched the vehicle, locating two walkie talkie radios, crow bars, grinders, screw drivers, hammers, balaclavas, torches and gloves in the car. Police also located a Dolce Gabanna ladies handbag with cash and keys inside, as well as a number of ladies polo shirts, with tags still attached. The males were subsequently arrested and taken to Chatswood Police station. A 17 year old Chester Hill male was later charged with being 'Armed with intent to commit an indictable offence,' 'Possess means of disguising face with intent to commit an indictable offence,' 'Possess housebreaking implements,' and 'Goods in custody.' He was granted conditional bail to appear at Hornsby Children's Court on the 19/2/09. A 32 year old Chester Hill male, who was already on bail for similar offences, was also charged with 'Armed with intent to commit an indictable offence,' 'Possess means of disguising face with intent to commit an indictable offence,' 'Possess housebreaking implements,' and 'Repeat Indictable Offence, having previous conviction.' He was refused bail and appeared at Hornsby Local Court on the 28/1/09, where he was remanded in custody to appear again on the 11/3/09
