**Re: Long Gully Bridge safety barrier on public display
Saturday 6 February at Northbridge Oval**

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) will host a community information day on **Saturday 6 February** about the Long Gully Bridge project.

The NSW Coroner recommended the installation of a safety barrier on Long Gully Bridge to increase public safety on and under the bridge.

This \$1.5 million project is fully funded by the NSW Government.

The community information day will be held at Northbridge Oval car park, Sailors Bay Road, Northbridge from **10am to 3pm**. Please drop in anytime during these hours.

A sample of the safety barrier will be on display and members of the project team will be available to discuss the construction of the safety barrier on Long Gully Bridge.

Start of construction

The RTA expects to commence installation of the safety barrier on Long Gully Bridge on Monday 22 February 2010. Work is scheduled for completion in May 2010, weather permitting.
