Re: Installation of the safety fence on Long Gully Bridge, Northbridge

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is continuing with the installation of the safety fence on Long Gully Bridge, Northbridge.

After about a month of work, the drilling and anchoring is almost complete. The next step is the installation of the safety fence, which will commence in mid April 2010. The project is still scheduled for completion in May 2010, weather permitting.

Residents are reminded that there continues to be some noise associated with the work.

The RTA is undertaking work during the day and night, with the majority of work to occur at night to minimise the impact on traffic on the bridge:

- Day work hours are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturdays 7am to 1pm.
- Night work hours are Sunday to Thursday from 8pm to 5am.

To provide respite from the noise of installing the safety fence, there will be no work on more than two consecutive nights.

The project team will also undertake some maintenance works on the bridge to coincide with this work. The maintenance works will involve minor concrete repairs and will take approximately one week to complete. This work will occur as part of the installation of the safety barrier with no expected increase in noise.

Work will **not** be undertaken on Easter Sunday, 4 April.
